BECOMING A BOARD MEMBER/TRUSTEE

The Board of the Trust is responsible for overseeing and carrying out activities in the name of the organisation.

That means the Board has to make decisions on behalf of the organisation's members and beneficiaries and is responsible for ensuring funders' conditions of grant are met.

To become a Trustee/Director, you should be an Ordinary Member of the Trust, resident in the community and entitled to vote in the Glentrool & Bargrennan polling district. You should also support the aims and purposes of the Trust.

The Board of Glentrool & Bargrennan Community Trust may have up to nine elected Directors.

Because the Trust is a Company Limited by Guarantee, the names and details of Directors have to be lodged with Companies House.

Nominations for the Board are normally supported by a Proposer and a Secunder, who should be Ordinary Members of the Trust. In the event of there being more nominations than there are vacancies available, the choices will be made by show of hands at the meeting where the elections are being held (usually the Annual General Meeting).

The Trust's regular meetings are held monthly on a weekday evening from 7p.m. to 9p.m.
